THE DISTRICT D'S OF MOSQUITO PREVENTION

DRAIN standing water that may produce mosquitoes.

DAWN and **DUSK** are times to avoid being outdoors. These are the times when mosquitoes are most active.

DRESS appropriately by wearing long sleeves and pants when outside and mosquitoes are around.

DEFEND yourself against mosquitoes by using an effective insect repellent that contains DEET, Picaridin, Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus or IR3535. Remember to follow label directions!

DOOR and window screens should be in good working condition. This will prevent mosquitoes from entering your home.

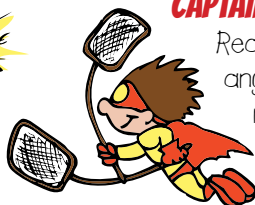
BUSTER GIRL

Ready to swat anytime, anywhere, no matter where!



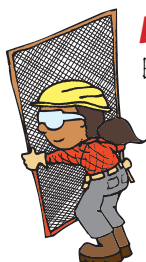
DRESS WIZARD

By healing doors and screen holes, she keeps mosquitoes outside where they belong!



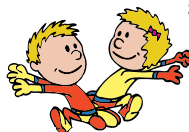
DRAIN MASTER

Keeping mosquitoes away with an array of repellents, the Defender helps everyone Fight the Bite!



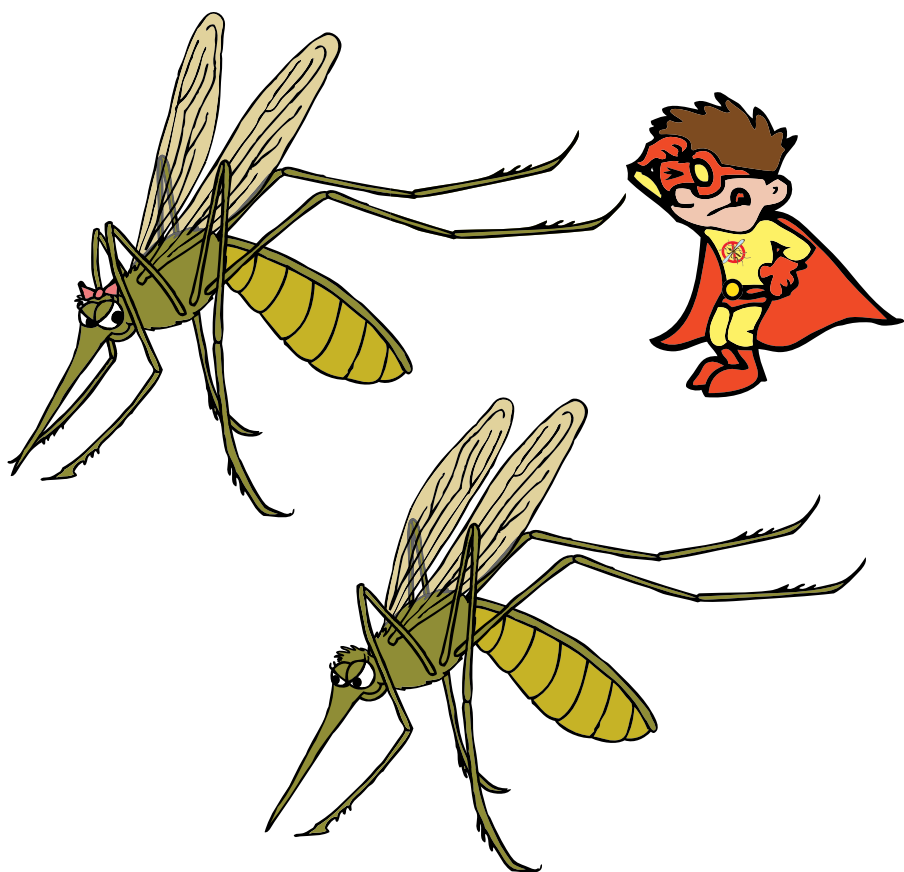
THE DISTRICT KID

The Kid is always prepared and ready to keep everyone aware of the District Ds.



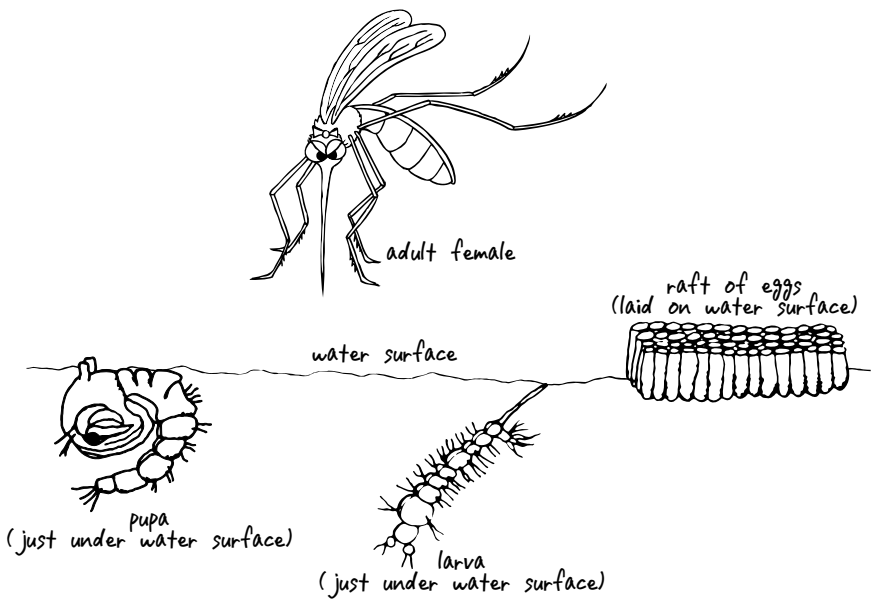
MEET THE MOSQUITOES!

When mosquitoes bite they make you itch and can also transmit diseases like West Nile virus. Only female mosquitoes bite and drink blood, while male mosquitoes only drink nectar. Can you spot the four differences between these two mosquitoes below?

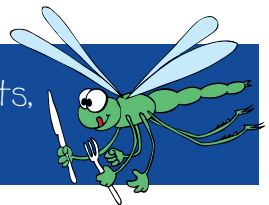


MOSQUITO LIFE CYCLE

Mosquitoes lay eggs on stagnant or green water. In warm weather, eggs can hatch and grow from larva to pupa in as little as seven to ten days. Color the different stages and draw arrows to show the life cycle of the mosquito.

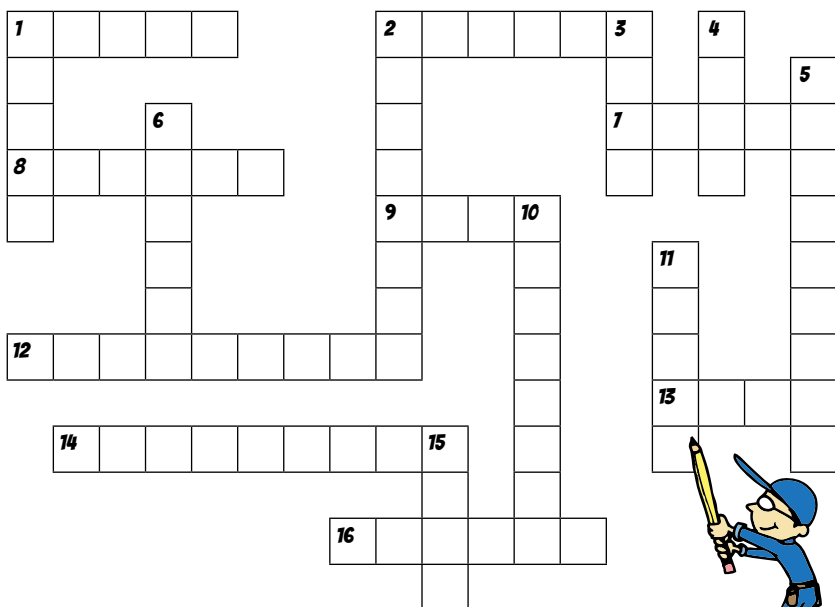


Adult dragonflies eat other flying insects, like midges and mosquitoes.

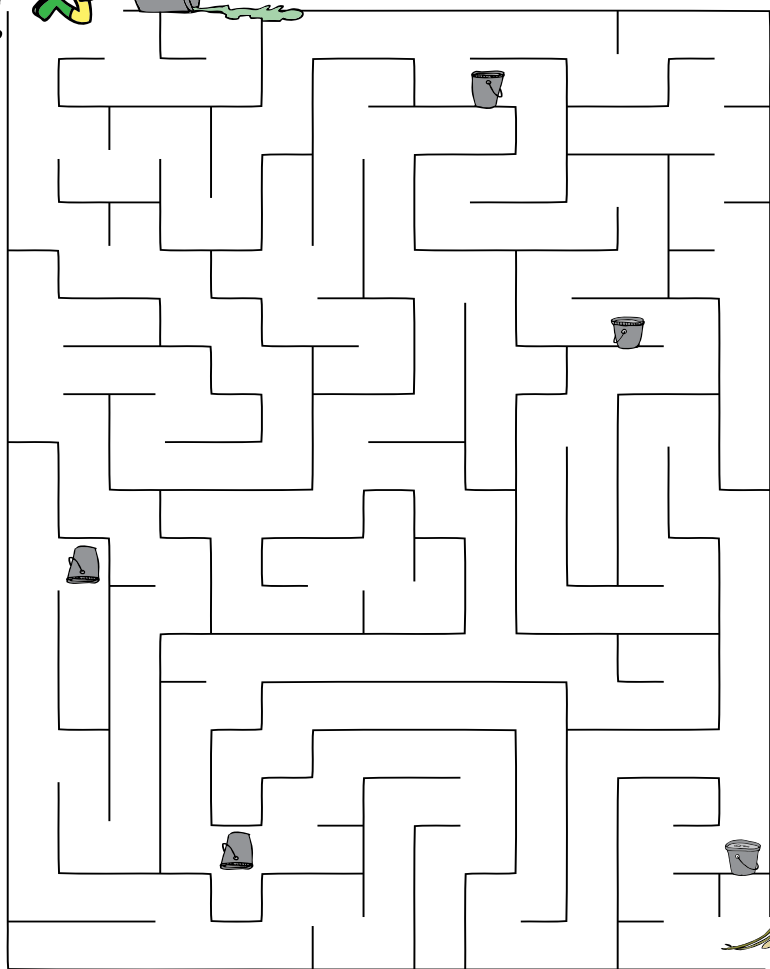
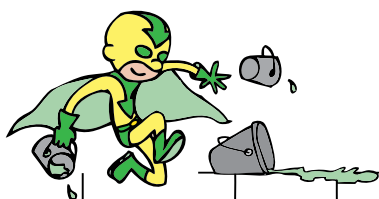

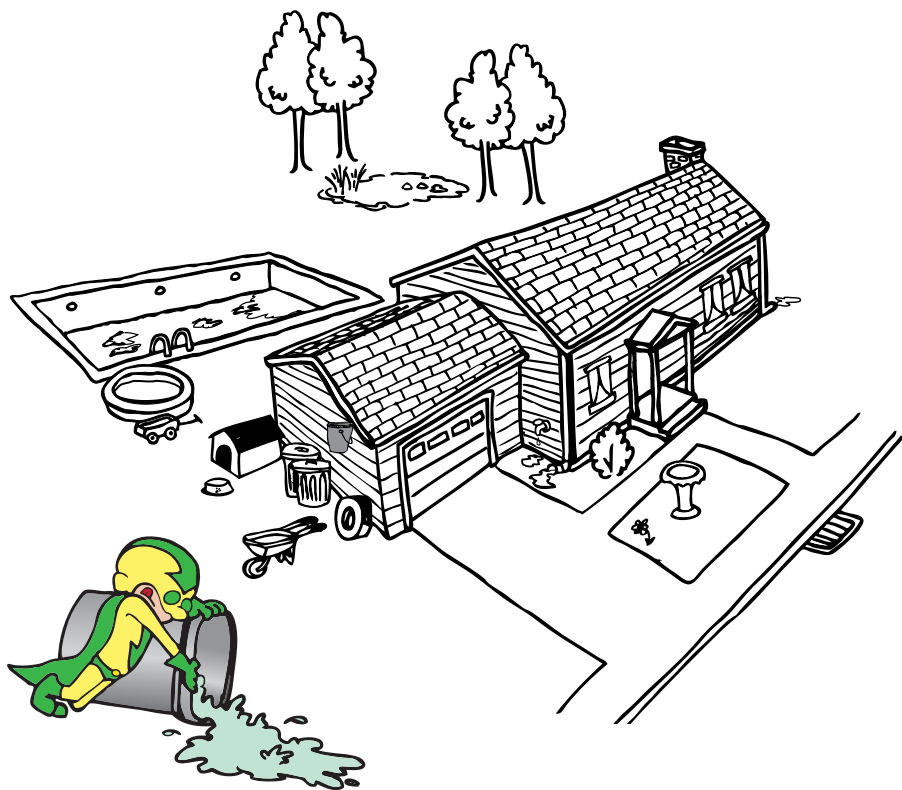
A-MAZE-ING

Be sure to **DRAIN** all buckets along the way!



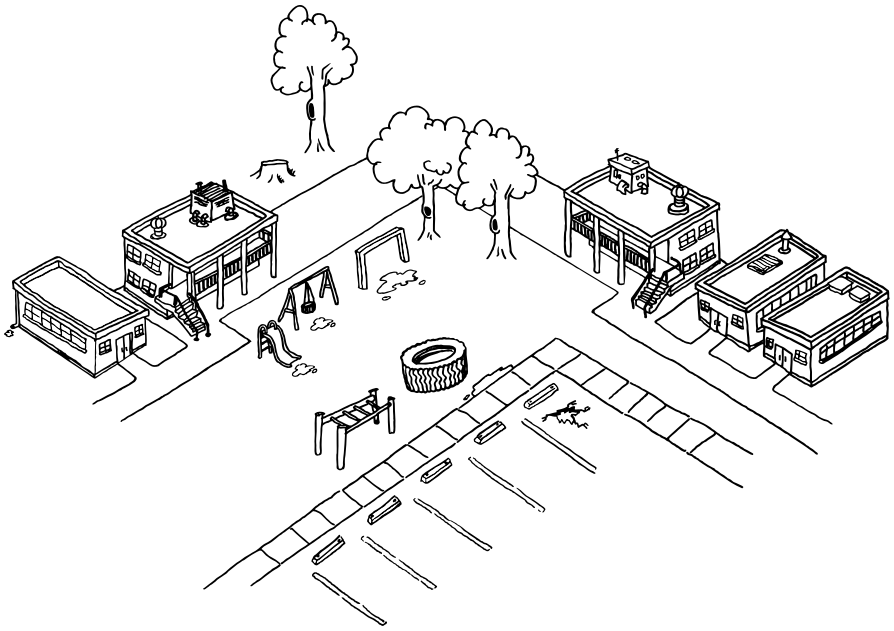
MISSION: DRAIN!

Some places where mosquitoes lay eggs include puddles, buckets, tires, toys, bird baths, pet dishes and neglected pools. **DRAIN** water from these places around your house to keep mosquitoes from growing in your backyard! Color the areas around your home where water can collect and mosquitoes can lay eggs.



Be your own Buster! Report neglected or green pools to an adult who can notify the District.

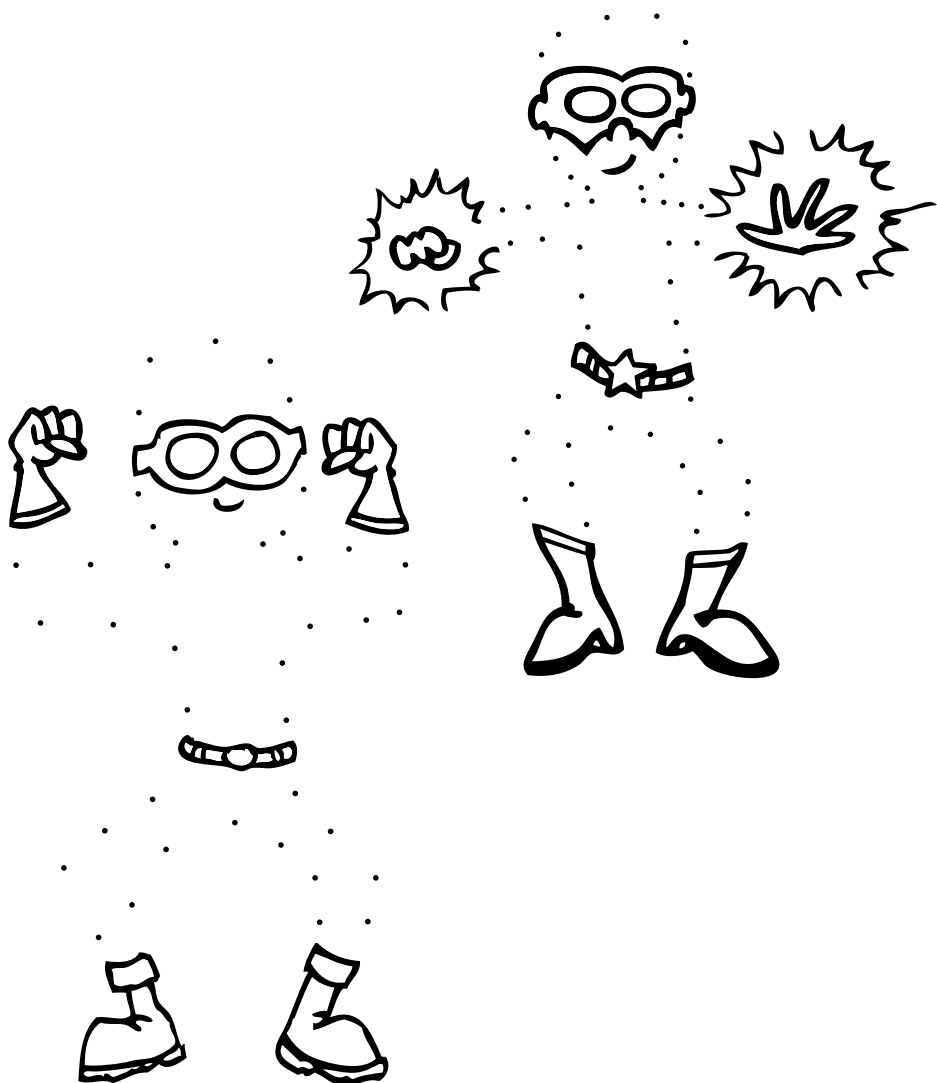
